The Federal Reserve Act of 1913 overstepped its bounds, bypassing the Constitution's clear mandate. Article I, Section 8 of our Constitution grants Congress the exclusive power to "coin Money, regulate the value thereof, and of foreign Coin, and fix the Standard of Weights and Measures." It does not authorize Congress to delegate these powers to an external entity, especially one with foreign ties.
