Notice Success Report- Killed Bill Massachusetts SAPHE 2.0 Bill

Details of Notice:

- **Notice Subject:** Massachusetts SAPHE 2.0 Bill Public Health Law Proposal. This bill aimed to centralize public health decisions within the state government, reducing local authority and community participation in health decisions.
- **Date Introduced:** July 22, 2024

Response:

- Action Taken by Recipient: The Massachusetts Legislature acknowledged the lawful notices during the committee hearing.
- Action Date: Deliberation extended by 10 days following the hearing.
- Compliance Status: Compliant

Outcome:

- **Result of Action:** The bill was nullified in full after the 10-day deliberation period, exactly as requested in the lawful notices.
- **Impact on Operations:** The notice forced the legislature to reconsider the bill's impact on local self-governance and public participation, leading to its cancellation.

Additional Comments:

This victory demonstrates the effectiveness of timely and organized lawful notices. The power of 95 individual notices compelled the legislature to stop a bill that could have centralized public health decisions and undermined local authority. The people's voices were heard, and the bill was successfully stopped.
